This is a story of 3 Des Moines area garages. The Pulley garage on the south side was old and rickety (and may have been made of sticks). The Sells framed garage was new (and made of wood). The Kruse garage was interesting (and had brick veneer).

Project Description:

The Pulley garage had settled. It was leaky and drafty and full of sports gear and tools

The Sells garage was new construction.

The Kruse garage was in good shape but needed an overhaul to work with the striking black brick veneer and cool contemporary architectural features.



Highlights of the Installation:

The Pulleys picked a high postconsumer content for maximum environmental benefit. Kelly Clear Faced Board provides a cover to crooked studs and provides strong walls for organization.



The Sells selected a colorful board. The plastic face is easy to clean, tolerates impact and hold screws. Kelly Paper Faced Board makes up the exterior sheathing and Kelly Clear faced Board provides the interior walls and ceilings



The Kruses used slick white and silver Kelly Clear Faced Board to align with their design scheme. The installers butted the joints expertly for a smooth, contemporary look.
